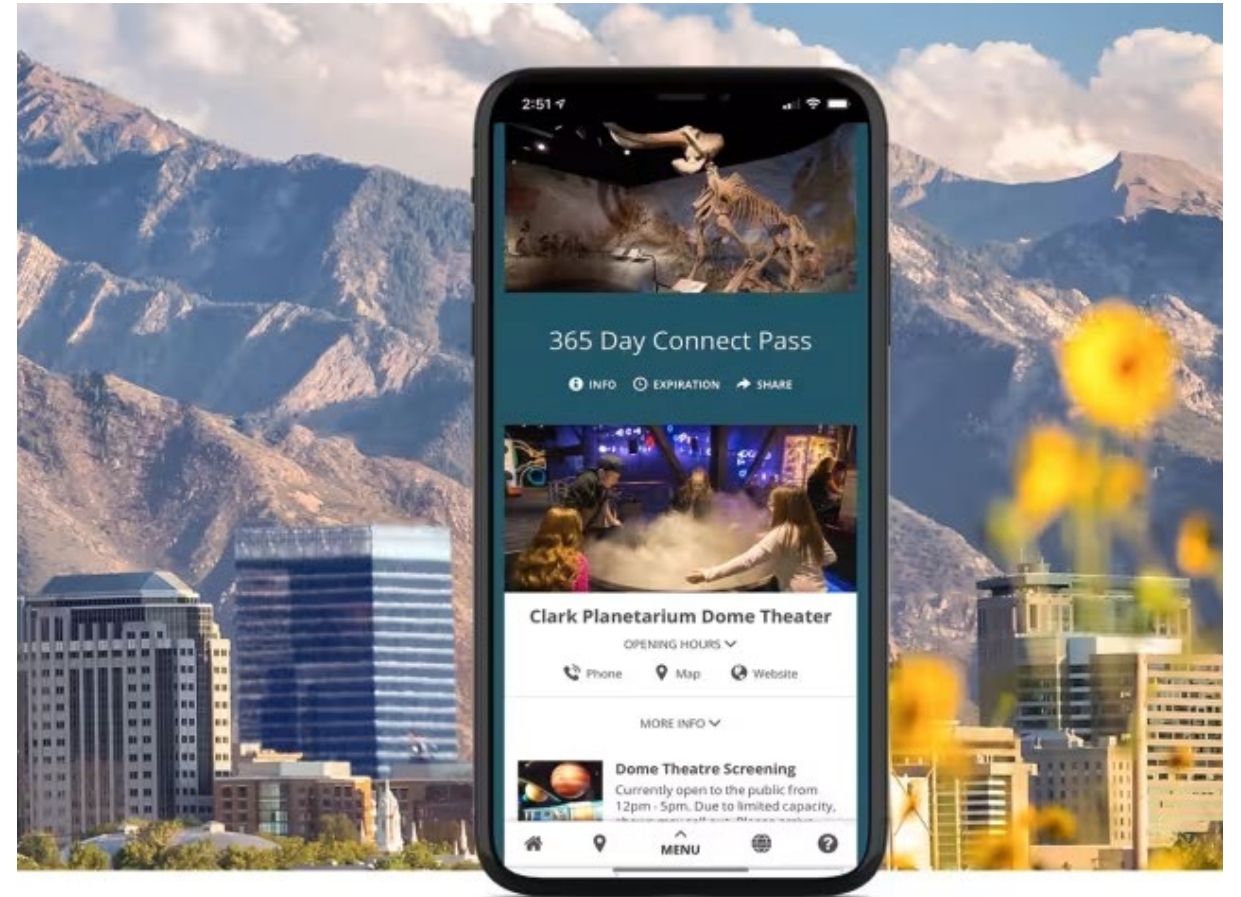

Olympic Enthusiasts

Utah Olympic Park

Utah Olympic Park, located in Park City, was built for the 2002 Winter Olympics. It features ski jumps, bobsled tracks and training facilities. Today, it's a year-round destination offering thrilling activities, Olympic history exhibits and athlete training grounds, attracting visitors and sports enthusiasts from around the world.

- **Bobsled and Skeleton Track:** The same track used in the 2002 Winter Olympics is open for public rides, reaching speeds of up to 70 mph
- **Nordic Ski Jumps:** The park features multiple ski jumps, including those used for ski jumping and Nordic combined
- **Ziplines and Alpine Slide:** The park offers various ziplines, including a steep extreme zipline, and an alpine slide for summer fun
- **Alf Engen Ski Museum and Eccles 2002 Olympic Winter Games Museum:** These museums showcase the history of skiing and the 2002 Winter Games
- **Adventure Courses and Drop Tower:** The park also has adventure courses and a drop tower for thrill-seekers
- **Guided Tours:** Guided tours are available to explore the park and learn about its history and facilities

Today, it's a public facility offering skating, fitness programs and elite athlete training, maintaining its Olympic legacy year-round.

- **Speed Skating:** The oval has the fastest ice in the world and is open for public skating and speed skating classes
- **Other Ice Sports:** The oval also offers ice skating, figure skating, and curling

Nature & Skiing

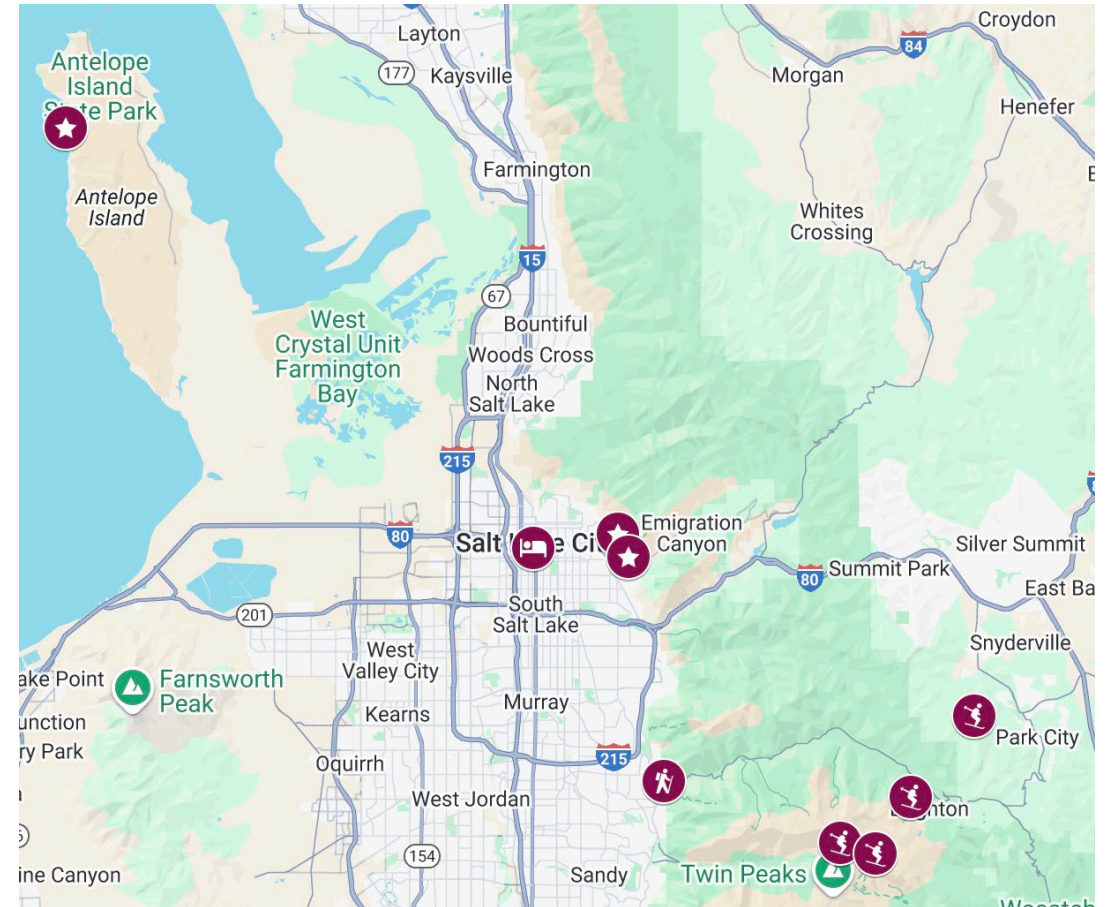

Temple Square:

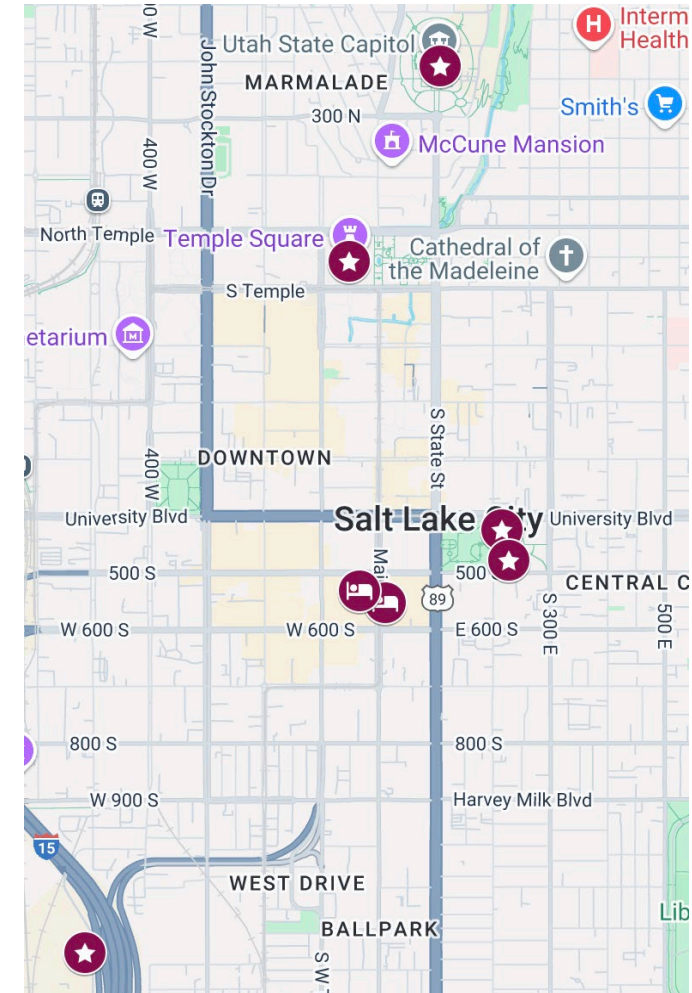

Shopping

City Creek Center

City Creek Center, opened March 22, 2012, is a 23-acre mixed-use development in downtown Salt Lake City featuring over 100 shops and restaurants, including Nordstrom and Macy's. Anchored by a retractable glass roof, creek, fountains, pedestrian skybridge and 5,000+ underground parking spaces, it blends luxury retail with urban green space.

Trolley Square

Trolley Square is a historic, partially enclosed shopping center in Salt Lake City, built in 1908 as electric streetcar barns and repurposed in 1972 into a charming marketplace with brick floors, wrought-iron balconies and a 97-ft water tower. As a beloved local landmark, it houses boutiques, eateries and a museum.

Clark Planetarium: Experience space through interactive exhibits and dome shows

If you're visiting Salt Lake City, don't miss the Clark Planetarium! Located at The Gateway, it's perfect for all ages with free interactive exhibits, stunning IMAX films, and a 3D dome theater that takes you to space and beyond. See a real moon rock and explore the universe.

Dreamscapes: A multi-sensory art installation with immersive environments

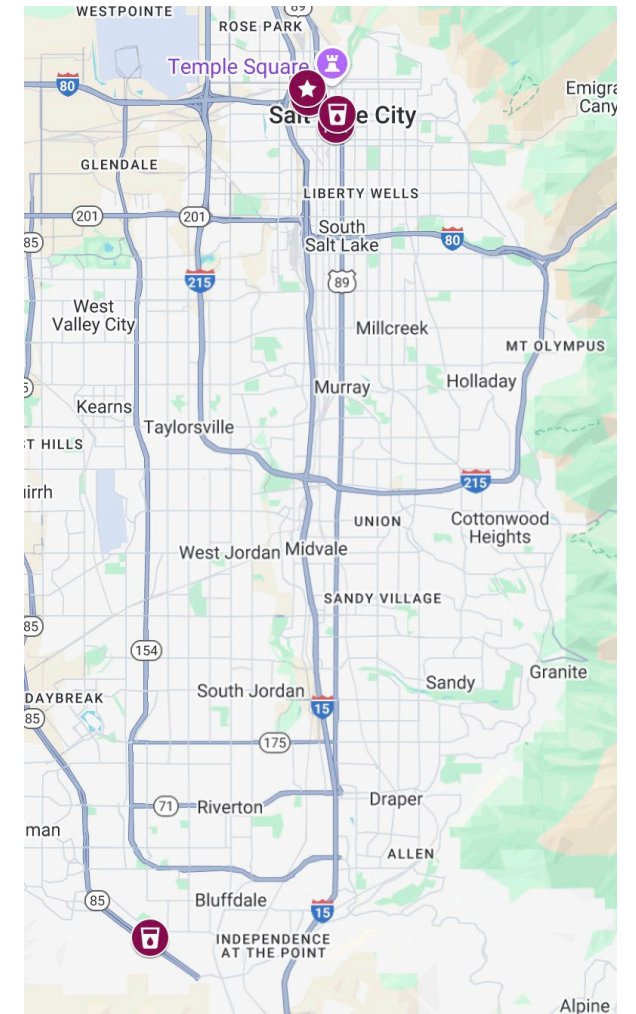
